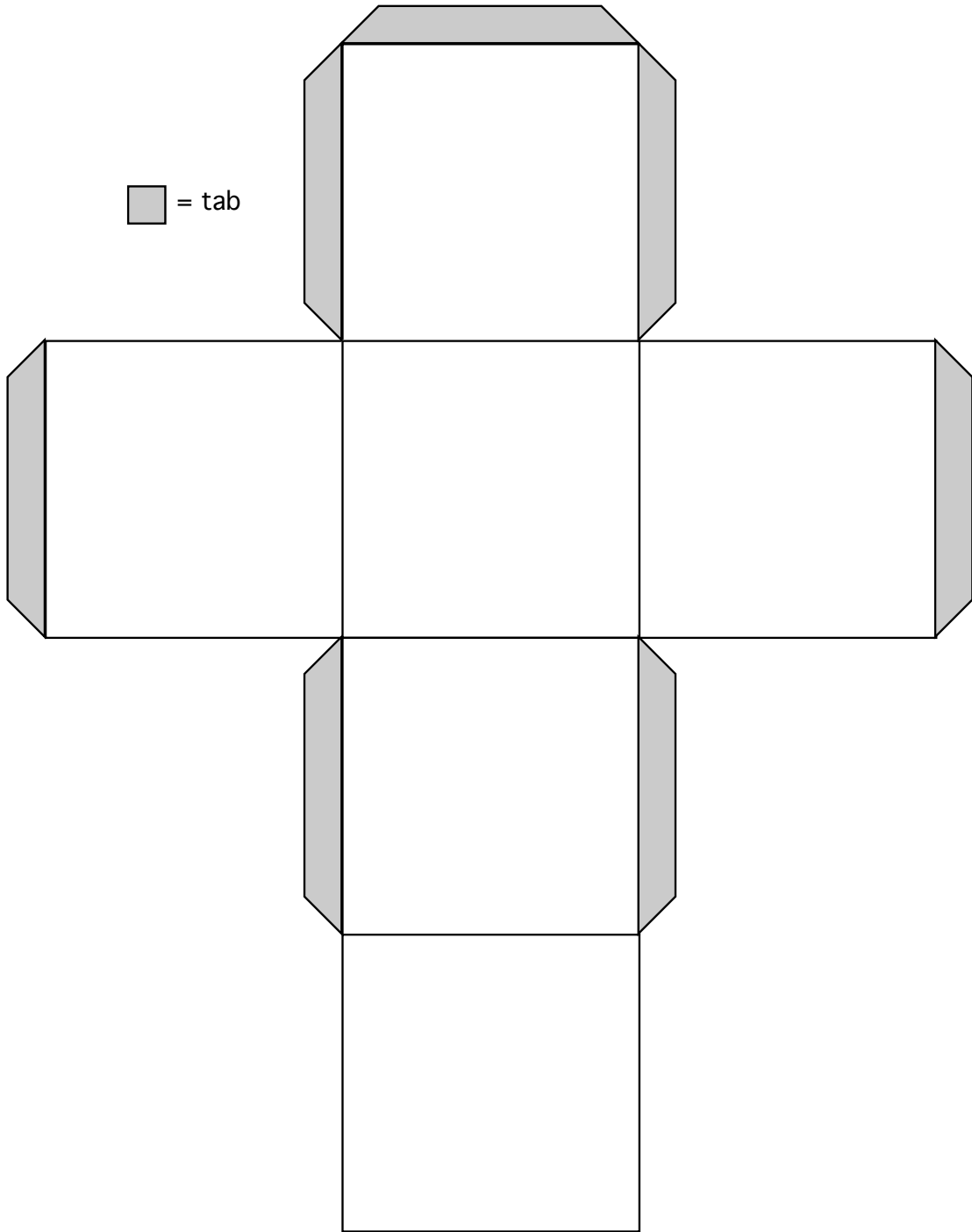


# Character Cube



This template for a Character Cube will entertain your students while it engages them in a lively pillar discussion. Print the cubes on card stock. Have students write one pillar word on each of the six squares and draw and color an illustration of that pillar in action. Students then cut it out and fold it on the lines, taping the sides to make the shape of a cube. With a buddy, students roll the cube to see which side faces up. They then explain how what's happening in the little illustration shows that pillar and their buddy can give another example of that pillar. Switch cubes or partners multiple times for some riveting game time. Or, let the students think up a dilemma about that pillar.
