A technology fee is included in the cost of all camps requiring use of computers. Activities are open to all students who meet the listed age requirements. Registrations are processed in the order received in the Community Ed Office. Register early to assure space in your selected activities.

If a class is cancelled, refunds will be processed mid-July. No refunds for withdrawal after June 6. However, with prior permission, students may be substituted (one for another) prior to the start of a class. Please list courses in order of preference in case some classes are full. Notifications made if classes not available. If you do not hear otherwise, please consider your child enrolled. Register by mail: Begins when summer flyer is available (print/online). Photocopied registration forms accepted. Registration at Bales begins Monday, June 9, 8 am-12 noon, through July 9 with Summer Supervisor on a space available basis.
