Questions & Answers

Q: Can individual items be selected from a Major Project scope sheet and considered individually?

A: The individual items are dependent or related to other itemized items and cannot be selected individually. The itemized breakdown is to allow an accurate cost study for varying costs for different types of scope and construction.

Q: Do school facilities or school improvements affect property values?

A: While many complicated factors affect property values, typically the quality of a school district and the quality of its school facilities have a direct correlation to a community's growth and related property values.

Q: What is the proposed increased square footage growth of Fine Arts, CTE and Athletics at the Friendswood High School Major Project?

A: The current proposed Friendswood High School additions will increase CTE square foot by an estimated 11,000 sqft, Athletics by an estimated 33,200 sqft, Band/Choir and support spaces by an estimated 4,000 sqft, and Auditorium and support spaces by an estimated 14,000 sqft.

Q: Have there been additions to the High School?

A: The High School Science Wing was included in the November 1997 Bond. The High School Front Office and Cafeteria Addition were included in the November 2007 Bond.

Q: Do the existing CTE spaces have Priority Maintenance items?

A: Renovation of existing CTE spaces, as well as other areas of the high school. There are also varying levels of maintenance items that will be addressed within the major project cost.

Q: How do we determine what is the most important/valuable CTE uses for the district, outside of considering the major project?

A: Programming phase determines the spaces based on the needs at the time.
